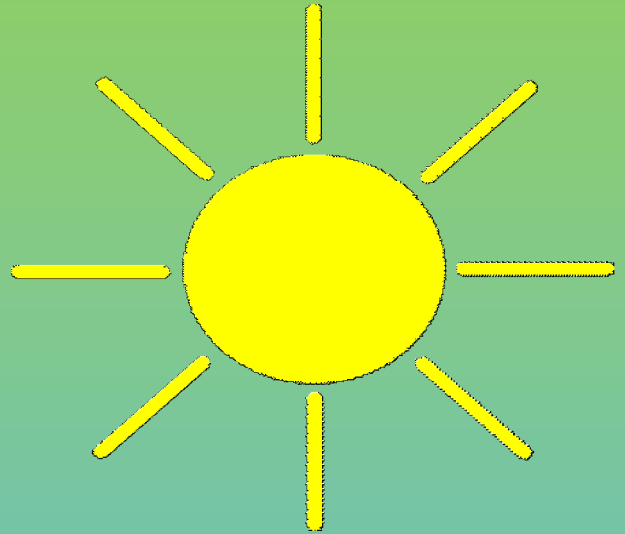

The Regional Prevention Coordinator Offers **FREE** Services to the Community

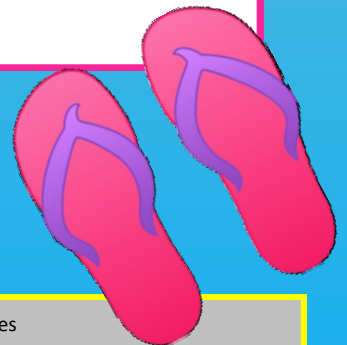
The Regional Prevention Coordinator (RPC) located at Red Rock Behavioral Health Services in Clinton, OK would like to remind the community of our services and what support the RPC can provide. The Red Rock RPC is one of 17 Regional Prevention Coordinators in the State of Oklahoma. Our primary focus is to serve as a community resource. Red Rock RPC educates and informs communities through multiple strategies including community based services, environmental strategies, early recognition, and referral. Red Rock RPC provides services to a two county area which includes: Canadian and Grady Counties.

Red Rock RPC takes a proactive approach in reducing substance abuse among communities, specifically underage drinking, fetal alcohol syndrome disorders, and the non-medical use of prescription drugs. They identify factors in a community that cause the risk of substance abuse and work to promote protective factors that serve to minimize the risk of substance use/abuse.

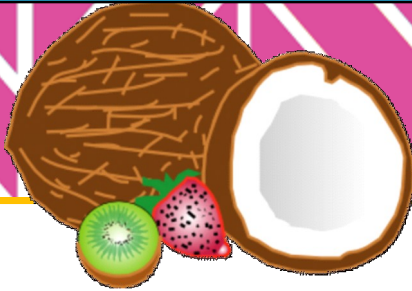

SUMMER RECIPES:

DESSERT PIZZA:

1 (18 oz.) packaged of sugar cookie dough; 1 (8 oz.) container of frozen whipped topping ;1/2 cup of sliced banana;

1/2 cup of sliced strawberries; 1/2 cup of seedless grapes, halved; 1/2 cup of crushed pineapple, drained.

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).

Press cookie dough evenly into a 12 inch pizza pan. Bake in preheated oven for 15 to 20 minutes, until golden brown. Cool in pan on wire rack.

Spread whipped topping over cooled crust. Arrange fruit in a decorative pattern. Refrigerate until ready to serve.
