SPF-PFS Grant Awarded in Grady County

Red Rock BHS is pleased to announce that they were recently one of the agencies in the State of Oklahoma to receive funding for the Oklahoma Strategic Prevention Framework Partnership for Success Grant, also known as the SPF-PFS project. The grant will focus on the prevention of the non-medical use of prescription drugs for persons 12-25 years of age.



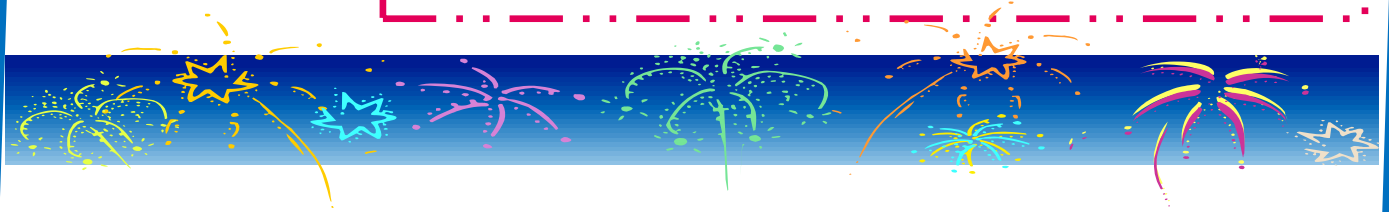
The project will include the completion of the Strategic Prevention Framework (SPF), which uses a five-step process known to promote youth development, reduce risk-taking behaviors, build assets and resilience, and prevent problem behaviors across the life span.

The SPF is built on a community-based risk and protective factors approach to prevention and a series of guiding principles that can be utilized at the federal, State/tribal and community levels.

The idea behind SPF is to use the findings from public health research along with evidence-based prevention programs to build capacity within States/Tribes/Territories and the prevention field. This in turn will promote resilience and decrease risk factors in individuals, families, and communities.

Red Rock looks forward to introducing this new grant and working in Grady County!

Red Rock SPF-PFS is a part of the Oklahoma SPF-PFS Project and is funded through SAMSA, CSAP, & ODMHSAS.

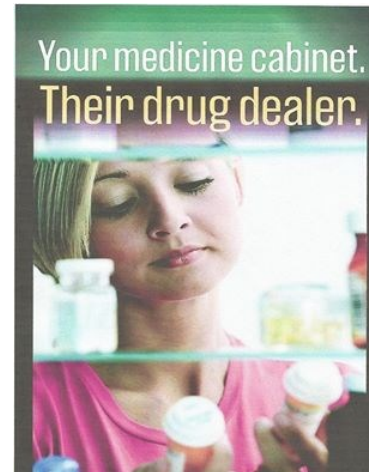

Do you have unused or expired prescriptions in your medicine cabinet and wondering how to dispose of them?

The purpose of these drop boxes are for citizens to dispose of their unused or unwanted prescriptions and keep them from getting into the wrong hands and appropriate disposal reduces the amount of prescription drug residue out of water sources. OBN also partners with an Oklahoma based company to destroy unused pharmaceuticals and turns it into green energy.

The process is simple: Take your unwanted or expired prescriptions to the police station and drop it in the box. There are no forms and no questions. It is FREE and Anonymous! The drop box does not allow syringes, chemicals, or inhalers.
