Oklahoma Prevention Needs Assessment 2016

The Oklahoma Prevention Needs Assessment is a survey that assesses substance abuse among 6th, 8th, 10th and 12th graders. It not only tells us WHAT is going on in our communities, but WHY it's going on. Here are some quick facts regarding the survey this year.

- Offered February 1-May 6, 2016
- It is free of charge
- Online version available
- Voluntary and offered to 6th, 8th, 10th and 12th graders
- At least passive consent is required from parents, but active consent is also available
- Assesses risk and protective factors
- Data collected can be used for grant opportunities for local schools
