## Coming Soon: Mustang Take Back Event

Do a quick inventory of your medicine cabinet. How many unused prescription pills are hanging out there? If you no longer need the medicine, a way to safe guard against prescription drug misuse is to dispose of the unwanted medicine in a prescription drug drop box. Canadian County prescription drop boxes continue to show they are successful in helping community members appropriately dispose of their unused prescription medicines. The appropriate disposal of prescription medication can reduce the occurrence of drugs being used non-medically and also keeps them out of our water

systems, as well as reduce the occurrence of drugs being used non-medically and also keeps them out of our water systems. **The drop boxes allow community members to dispose of their medications safely and anonymously.** Another way to dispose of left over medicine is to drop them off at community take back events. **April 11, 2014,** community members will have the opportunity to dispose their unused prescriptions at the **Mustang Prevention and Coalition Team (MPACT) prescription take back**

**event.** The event will take place during Relay for Life, in front of the Mustang High School Football field. **Medications can be dropped off anonymously from 5:30 pm-8:30 pm.**
