PIEDMONT DROP BOX

The Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics (OBN) will be installing a drug disposal box in Piedmont on October 2, 2013. The drop box will be located in the lobby of the Piedmont Police Department and community members are encouraged to utilize the drop box to safely dispose of their unused/unwanted prescription medications. In March of 2011, OBN began installing permanent take back boxes in law enforcement lobbies. To date 145 boxes have been installed across the state and OBN has collected approximately 48,000 pounds of home medication. Disposing of prescription medication is a way to fight prescription drug abuse and misuse, and is critical in reducing the risk of youth taking medication that has not been prescribed to them.



OBN has also placed drop boxes in Mustang, Yukon, and El Reno. The locations of the drop boxes are listed in the box below. Disposing of your medications is easy, convenient, and anonymous. The Piedmont drop box location address is: 400 Edmond Road NW Piedmont, Oklahoma 73078.



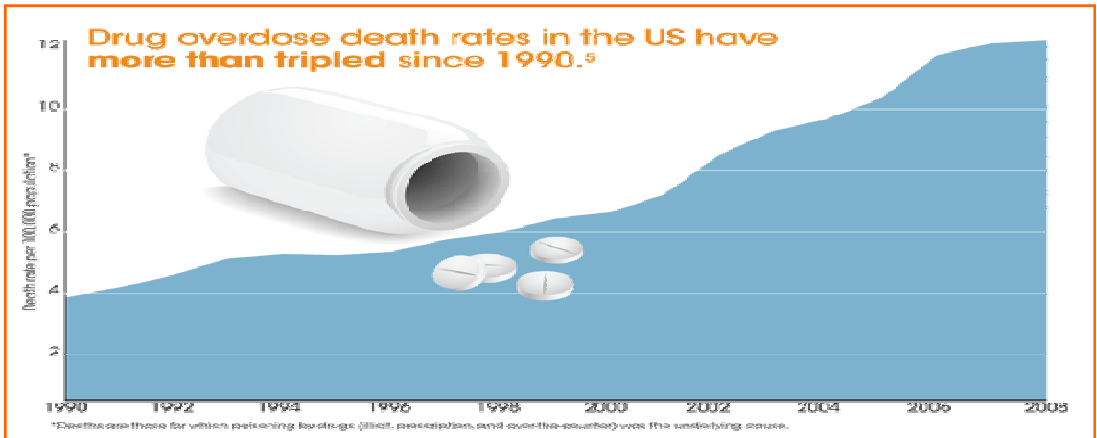
