Alcohol Compliance Checks in Chickasha

On October 10, 2014, the Regional Prevention Coordinator (RPC) in conjunction with Chickasha Police Department conducted nineteen alcohol compliance checks throughout Chickasha. Through the compliance checks, seventeen store clerks checked for an i.d. and did not sell alcohol to a minor.
