May is a month of graduations, graduation parties, and Memorial Day cookouts! But as these events take place, Red Rock RPC wants to remind you to plan ahead for your celebrations.

If you are hosting a party, please remember not to provide alcohol to youth. It can be very dangerous and is also a direct violation of Oklahoma's Social Host law.

A Social Host is anyone who provides a location for those under 21 to drink alcohol. A Social Host can be a minor or adult and doesn't have to be physically present to be the property owner. If someone is injured or killed due to the social host, it can result in a felony and is punishable with up to 5 years in prison and a \$2,500 fine.
