## Red Rock RPC Offers Free Training to Help Reduce Sales of Alcohol to Minors

### Canadian and Grady Counties (February 11, 2020) –

Red Rock Regional Prevention Coordinator would like the community to be aware that they offer a **FREE** Responsible Beverage Service and Sales (RBSS) Training to local retailers in Canadian and Grady Counties. There was a historic change in Oklahoma's alcohol laws in 2018, and as a result, it is now a requirement of any person applying for a new liquor license to sell alcohol to be trained in an ABLE Commission approved alcohol server training **within two weeks of applying for their license.**

Responsible Beverage Sales and Service Training (RBSS) is a partnership between the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission (ABLE). The training program provides owners, managers, and servers of establishments that serve/sell alcohol with the knowledge and skills to help them serve/sell alcohol responsibly and fulfill the legal requirements of alcohol service.

The **class is free of charge** and provides valuable Oklahoma specific alcohol merchant education.
